USE OF COVE ASSETS AND EQUIPMENT

Cove Assets and equipment are for official Cove use only. Chain saws, weed eaters, the tractor, the truck, and any equipment used by committees are for their official use only. Individuals may NOT borrow the equipment for personal use.

Equipment at the POA office including chairs and tables can only be used on premises...they cannot be loaned for off-site use, per the current WC Usage Agreement.

The Chipper use is administered by Firewise, and is available for use by those who have taken the required training.

HEMLOCK OWNERS: WOOLY ADELGIDS IN THE COVE!

A cove resident has found wooly adelgids infesting their hemlock trees. This condition is lethal over time if not treated. Treatment is possible by the homeowner, although it may be somewhat expensive, but this is not one of those situations which can be ignored. If you have hemlocks on your property, you should examine them immediately for small, white masses of cottony material on the twigs. Finding the condition does not mean your trees are going to die immediately, but you should implement a plan for protecting them.

The state forestry people are helpful, but will not tackle the problem on our behalf. I have spoken with Nathan Hoover, the forestry official responsible for this issue, and he suggested that it would be helpful if Cove residents treat this as a cooperative community issue. Forestry will provide treatment methodology, chemical information, and advice, on a continuing basis. He is sending me a package of information, which I will share with anyone interested. I have no prior experience with this insect, but am familiar with other tree diseases & pests (lethal yellowing, laurel wilt, emerald ash borer, & pine beetles) so am not starting from scratch. If residents would like assistance examining their trees, I would be glad to help.
